Each hour long session will help build your confidence and skills in a fun and friendly atmosphere with other women of similar abilities. The idea is to make your golf experience more enjoyable. The 7 week curriculum will touch on all aspects of the game. Classes meet every Tuesday Morning at 9:00. Learn the game while socializing with friends, old & new. Plenty of personal attention and instruction await you at The Links.

Week 1: Introduction-Etiquette and Rules

We start with the very basics: How to dress, Where to stand, Talk or whisper, Order of play, Mark or putt-out. Rules: Water Hazards, Out of Bounds, Lost ball, etc. Don't worry about review, as each week we will touch upon situational etiquette and rules.

Week 2 & 3: The Short-Game

The short-game, which includes all those shots played around the green, such as putting, chipping and pitching, generally these shots account for 50% or more of the average golfers score. So we simplify half the game in just two weeks.

Week 4: Grip, Stance and Alignment & Swing Motion

The three fundamentals - How to hold the club, how to stand and how to align your body for proper aim. They seem harmless enough, but these simple actions are core to the other weekly topics and will be revisited frequently.

Week 5: Making a Full Swing - Irons

Once you have learned a bit about the short game the full swing will not seem nearly as complicated. Lessons from weeks 2-4 will be incorporated as you begin hitting full golf shots

Week 6: Making a Full Swing - Woods

Hitting a good tee shot makes the game so much easier, but don't worry about hitting the ball far. Straight and in the fairway is the key. This week we'll incorporate all that you have learned to date.

Week 7: Lets Play Golf!

After a brief warm-up on the range your instructor will lead you on the course for a round of golf. This gives you an opportunity to practice what you've learned, plus, you'll get to ask questions regarding rules and etiquette. This is a great chance to reduce the "fear factor" related to golf.
